What Just Happened?

1.	Two disciples are reeling from dashed hopes (Luke 24:13–24).
	These two followers of Jesus are disappointed and discouraged because Jesus didn't turn out to be whom they thought!
2.	Jesus addressed their disappointment by showing them what they overlooked (Luke 24:25–29).
	When we don't affirm everything God says in His Word, we are sitting ducks for disappointment with God.
3.	Once they saw the bigger picture and the light dawned, Jesus revealed Himself to them (Luke 24:30–35).
	Trusting what Jesus says more than personal perceptions can transport us from despair to joy.
