John 13:1-4

- 1. **Definition of Oneness** (17:21–23)
  - A. Oneness means doing what Father does. John 5:19; 10:32, 37–38; John 8:29; 5:30
  - B. Oneness means saying what Father says. John 8:28; 12:50; 14:9–11
- 2. **Basis of Oneness** (17:20)

Our part is quite simple; the Holy Spirit handles the rest. John 12:42–48; John 14:16–17, 20, 26; 16:7, 13–14

- 3. Fruit from Oneness (17:21, 23)
  - A. Our message to the world becomes believable.
  - B. Our identity is revealed.
